



A STORY FROM RIO DA HUILA, ANGOLA

Rio da Huila Medical Center is a strategic outreach to Ovamuila/ Nyaneka communities who are discovering new life in Christ through discipleship and holistic impact. Community health care provides open doors for both global workers and local believers to bring the gospel to hard-to-reach places.

Through primary health care, dentistry, sustainable agriculture, nutrition assistance, and maternal-infant preventive care programs, we seek to empower people for the betterment of their spiritual and physical well-being through discovering a rich and vibrant life in Christ. Rio da Huila Church and its daughter churches use the Center as a referral hospital for many of their new churches and preaching points. As a result, church workers bring patients to receive medical treatment, often for the first time, in a Christian environment using modern medicine instead of resorting to local witch doctors.

The Medical Imaging and Diagnostics department at Rio da Huila Medical Center includes X-rays, ultrasounds, audiometry, Holter ECG monitoring, spirometry for asthma evaluations, and the addition of microbiology and hemotherapy services to the laboratory. ANGOLA

A STORY FROM TORONTO, CANADA

We praise God for the incredible ways He has worked in Toronto through the lives of international students and newcomers to Canada. Over the past year, we have encountered many challenges in our ministry, but through them, we have witnessed successes that can only be attributed to God's provision and guidance.

Living and serving in Toronto comes with its share of financial challenges, but the deep purpose of our ministry-being a presence where it is most needed-keeps us grounded in our mission. God has continually provided us with unique housing, which has enabled us to extend hospitality to those we serve. Through this hospitality, we have seen many hearts open to a deeper understanding of God, and some have even come to know Him as their Lord and Savior.

When we were unexpectedly notified of an eviction from our landlord (who said they needed the house to themselves), it came as a surprise, bringing with it new challenges for both our family and ministry. Housing in Toronto is notoriously expensive, leaving us to wonder what God had in store for us next. Yet, through the ups and downs, God worked in ways we could never have imagined, providing us with the means to purchase a home in our desired neighborhood. This new space is not only large enough to accommodate our family, but it also allows us to continue hosting homestay students and serving many others who come into our lives.

This home has become a hub for r elationships, allowing us to build connections, share the Gospel, and further our goal of fostering a community. One of the highlights of this year has been the opportunity to start a beginner Bible study, which has attracted a diverse group of students and newcomers. We are encouraged by the rich conversations and the spiritual growth we are witnessing.

Above all, we rejoice in the transformation of lives. Three students have come to faith, and we have had the privilege of baptizing two of them. Their stories reflect the heart of our ministry: reaching the unreached nations of the world by touching lives right here in Canada. These students are now sharing their newfound faith with family and friends back home, multiplying the impact of this ministry in ways we could never have imagined.

We are filled with excitement and anticipation for what God will continue to do in and through this ministry. It is clear that His hand is at work, and we are grateful to be part of this.
